### II. Where We Are – Debrief from last meeting

We are working on the website where we will upload agendas and minutes constantly.

Process and timeline for funding will be finalized soon. We are working on a process to offer funding to the bubbles.

What is the process to update structure? We have a leadership team comprising the quad chairs and co-coordinators. We will continue thinking about the structure of our committee, the leadership, and the bubbles.

### IIIa. Shared Metrics

Because Shared Metrics supports all bubbles, Shared Metrics proposed that their bubble be disbanded. They found they were repeating the same information in multiple venues. The Committee Agreed.

### IIIb. Inclusive Decision Making

Facing the same struggles on meeting times, decision making, group communication with each other, using meetings effectively, and getting things out to campus. We need to go where the people are, start to enforce responsibilities and more trainings for chairs.

### IIIc. Guided Major and Career Exploration

Haven't met since we are still working on some areas of interest like mentoring faculty. Olivia Picolla and Shawn Fawcett will Co-Chair this group in anticipation of Manuel Velez's move to the Academic Senate's Presidency. Manuel will remain on the bubble.

### IIId. Improve Basic Skills

After the BSSOT Funds Sunset, What projects will move to Pathways? What will guide Pathways fund?

### IIIe. Clear Program Requirements

Clear program requirements plan to use the LOFT to invite highlighted disciplines to gather, meet, and discuss Pathways and program planning in an interdisciplinary way. Opportunities will also be created for CurricUNTE tutoring, assistance and cleanup.

### IIIf. Proactive and Integrated Student Supports

PIZZAS suggested that the reporting order rotate or perhaps that only highlighted bubbles report out, but for a longer time, to allow to share. PIZZAS will begin working on a logic model to help the bubble establish its goals.
