    - a. John said the position paper guidelines should take this fact into account.
- B. Position Paper #8 (Program Discontinuance):
  - 1. Arlis reported no process currently exists for the college to notify students when their program is discontinued.
  - 2. The VPI initially schedules a meeting to review a program with the School Dean.
    - a. Cost and availability of Faculty to teach courses are two factors that may be considered.
    - b. Additional meetings may be scheduled with the Department Chair(s) and Faculty.
    - c. Additional meetings may also be scheduled with the other School Deans on campus.
  - 3. The college needs to look at the employment outlook in the region for positions in the field when reviewing a program.
  - 4. The college needs to ensure that students currently in the program can finish the program before it is fully discontinued.
  - 5. Faculty needs to find out how they can protect their programs.
