Comments from Arlis Svedberg:

- 1. The Mesa College ESOL Program is an accelerated program with the goal of allowing students to acquire high fluency in a second language, which normally requires seven years of instruction and heavy immersion, and develop competency at the college level in two years.
- 2. Mesa College's ESOL Program provides a vital pathway for our students to accomplish the following:
 - a. Prepare for Transfer-Level courses.
 - b. Fulfill Prerequisite Requirements prior to transfer.
 - c. Pursue Associate's degrees.
 - d. Receive training for higher-level positions in their chosen fields.
 - e. Pursue Certificates.
 - f. Concurrently take courses in other disciplines with their ESOL instruction with support from the ESOL program.
- 3. The success rate for Mesa College's ESOL students is 81% for English courses and 79% for other courses.
