General Tutoring

To tutor in the tutoring center, all prospective General Tutors must:

- Enroll in a one-unit, three-week-long hybrid course (EDU 100) paid for by student.
 - Two class meetings for three hours each
 - Online homework and discussion boards plus observation of current tutors.
