

To be eligible for admission to the Animal Health Technology Program, a candidate **must:**

- submit a completed application
  - provide proof of a tetanus toxoid vaccination within the last eight (8) years on the first day of classes
  - provide proof of a negative TB (tuberculosis) test administered within the thirty (30) days prior to the start of classes
1. Prior to submitting an application, the candidate must first apply for admission to San Diego Mesa College. This must be done on-line at <http://studentweb.sdccd.edu>.
  2. Dead line for submission of the completed application packets is May 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. Completed packets are accepted year round and can be mailed to the Special Admissions Clerk or delivered in person during normal Admissions Office hours.
  3. As a **totally completed** packet is submitted, it is given a "sequential priority number". The following constitute a "totally complete" packet: Application, Official Transcript(s), Orientation Certificate (optional), Competency Documentation, and "Work In Progress" certificate, if currently enrolled in a prerequisite course.
  4. **Completed** packets are numbered as they are submitted. Admission into the AHT Program is on a "first come – first served basis", with up to thirty (30) applicants being accepted into the entering class.
  5. If less than thirty (30) applications are received the application deadline will be extended until the entry class is full.
  6. If an applicant is not accepted into the next entering class and the applicant is still interested in entering the Animal Health Technology Program, a new completed application must be submitted for the following academic year.
  7. Any candidate wishing to change their application status (withdraw or cancel) must provide immediate written communication to San Diego Mesa College Special Admissions Clerk.
