Add “Special Conditions for the Theatre Arts Option:

Articulation with local community colleges has influenced the development of the Option in Theatre Arts. A primary goal of CSUSM is to complement existing theatre programs in the region. Students currently must take introductory studio, history, theory, and survey courses in theatre at other institutions (these courses are offered at neighboring community colleges) in order to fulfill the Preparation for the Major requirements. Additionally, with the approval of the department chair, up to 9 units of lower-division transfer coursework can be counted toward satisfaction of the major requirements. Theatre coursework taken at other institutions may be applied to the theatre major only with approval by the department chair.”
