Need 10000 people for it by 4/17/11. Lastly, SB1440 long discussion (2 transfer degrees our district will move forward with, we are putting together 3 agreements, 1 to satisfy the state, 1 to satisfy the state and CSU (not SDSU), and 1 to satisfy state, CSU and SDSU)

 - State budget (Carroll) “very strange budget discussions”, 400 mil reduction to CC’s, offset income for student fees is more like 290 mil cut, method for reduction will be workload not census. Deferral 129 mil which will put pressure on our reserves. LAO has a laundry list of recommendations if ballot doesn’t pass (cut PE, cut BSI)
 - Student voter registration (Neault) on reg-e there is a link to register online, sending emails to remind students to vote.
 - AS Degree from transfer (SB1440) (Lee) Discussion regarding a need for a centralized state degree and a local degree to satisfy SDSU.

 - June ballot looks better. 4 conservative senators are holding out putting the bill out to the people to have a right to vote on it.
 - AB 661 was introduced, Block authored this, but had no input from SDCCD, yet City College would be the pilot. AB661 has many issues: no start up money, bargaining issues, accreditation issues, conflict with CSU, impact funding K-14
 - Roundtable (Umstot) talked about the LA community college bond mess, (Bravo) talked about Hand Across California, would like Classified to be involved.
