ASSOCIATE DEGREE REQUIREMENTS 2008-2009

Students planning to TRANSFER should see a counselor for information about the Liberal Arts and Sciences ASSOCIATE IN ARTS requirement.

ELIGIBILITY FOR GRADUATION:

1. Complete a minimum of 60 Associate Degree applicable units.
2. Complete all units required for the major of your choice (A minimum of 18 units of course work; however, many majors require more than 18 units – refer to Mesa College catalog for specific major course requirements).
3. Complete a minimum of 12 units in residence as an officially enrolled student in the SDCCD.
4. Complete a minimum of 18 units of General Education courses, with a minimum of one course in each sub-area.
5. Complete/Satisfy District Requirement courses.
6. Maintain a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 (“C” grade or higher) for all work attempted. **Students enrolled in occupational and health occupation programs must earn a grade of “C” or better in courses required for the major.*

Note: Students who are following a different catalog year should refer to previous catalogs for other approved courses.
