

Choosing The Right English Classes

Before you choose an English class, you need to know what your English skill level is. ClassTalk will not enroll you in a class if your skill level is lower than the skill level stated as the requirement (prerequisite) for that class. To find out what your skill level is, you can take an English placement test or submit a transcript from another college if you've taken English classes elsewhere.

The placement tests are given by the DSPS Test Proctoring Office. There are three tests: an ESL test (for students learning English as a second language), an English test (for native speakers of English) and the SAT HI test for Deaf students. **Please take the proper test to avoid misplacement, delay and confusion.**
