Examples of Honors Activities

Attending or presenting at an Honors Program Orientation (August)

Attending an Honors Club meeting (bi-weekly during fall and spring semesters)

Attending an Honors Club workshop:

- * transfer workshop (September / October / March)
- * personal essay writing (October)
- * UC application workshop
- * personal essay editing (November)
- * CV writing (April/May)

Attend a CC2U event (usually late October/early November)

Go to UCLA TAP Day with the Honors Program (mid-late November)

Attend the CC2U symposium (February)

Attend HTCC practice sessions (February)

Present research the Mesa College Honors Symposium (late February/ early March)



Examples of Honors Activities, continued

Present research at, or attend the HTCC Conference at UCI (March)

Present research at, or attend a BHC conference at Stanford or Cal Berkeley (late April)

Attend an arts or cultural event of your choice with other Mesa College honors students, such as a performance of the San Diego Symphony, a film festival, a play, etc. Students must submit a digitized 250 – 300 word critical response to the event.
