- Must show deserving character (biographical essay)
- Have completed at least three Black Studies classes
- Letters of recommendation (2)
- Submit a unique form of self-expression (1)
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.5

Application Deadline Feb. 29, 2012

Completed applications and all supporting documents must be received by 5:00 P.M. on Feb. 29, 2012. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

Recipient Notification and Release of Scholarship Award

Recipients will be notified by early April. Awards will be presented on April 27, 2012 at the Annual Scholarship Awards Banquet. Attendance at the Scholarship Banquet is strongly encouraged so that your achievements can be celebrated and the generosity of the donors publicly acknowledged.
