Scholar Award (Full-time)

This scholarship fund was established by Mesa College in order to lend support to two (2) matriculating scholars deserving of financial assistance.

To be eligible, the student will have to meet the following criteria:

- Be currently enrolled in 12 units at Mesa College
- Be an active member of the BSU
- Must show deserving character (biographical essay)
- Have completed at least three Black Studies classes
- Letters of recommendation (2)
- Submit a unique form of self-expression (1)
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.5

Application Deadline Feb. 28, 2011

Completed applications and all supporting documents must be received by 5:00 P.M. on Feb. 28, 2011. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

Recipient Notification and Release of Scholarship Award

Recipients will be notified by early April. Awards will be presented on April 29th, 2011 at the Annual Scholarship Awards Banquet. Attendance at the Scholarship Banquet is strongly encouraged so that your achievements can be celebrated and the generosity of the donors publicly acknowledged.
