CLASSIFIED SENATE DEPENDANT SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship fund was established by the Mesa College Classified Senate to support the dependant of a contract classified employee of Mesa College in successfully achieving their educational goals. The scholarship fund is supported by donations from Mesa College staff and the Classified Senate.

TO BE ELIGIBLE, APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- Be the dependant of a contract classified employee at Mesa College (employee must have been employed with the District for at least one (1) year)
 - Be currently enrolled in at least 12 units at Mesa College
 - Have completed a minimum of 6 units
 - Have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale for courses completed
- * **Verification of dependant status must be provided by Ursula Salbato, District Human Resources Department.**

APPLICATION DEADLINE FEBRUARY 29, 2012

Completed applications and all required supporting documents must be received by 5:00 p.m. on February 29, 2012. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

SELECTION PROCESS AND CRITERIA

All completed applications that meet eligibility requirements will be reviewed by a committee composed of representatives from the Mesa College, classified staff, student government, administration, and Mesa College Foundation.

APPLICATIONS WILL BE RATED AS FOLLOWS:

GPA of 3.0 and higher	10 points maximum
Internships/Community Service	30 points maximum
Essay	60 points maximum

RECIPIENT NOTIFICATION AND RELEASE OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Recipients will be notified by mid-April. Awards will be presented on Friday April 27, 2012, at the Annual Scholarship Awards Banquet. Recipients will be honored as special guests and will receive one complimentary dinner ticket. Attendance at the Scholarship Banquet is strongly encouraged so that your achievements can be celebrated and the generosity of the donors publicly acknowledged.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Applicants are requested to submit the following documentation:

1. Submit a fully completed biographical questionnaire. All information requested must be provided.
2. Submit **unofficial** transcripts.
3. Submit verification of community service (Example: letter of recognition, certificate of appreciation, etc.)
4. Submit a well-written original essay on a topic selected from any of the following subjects. Be sure to follow the recommended length of 500 words or less. The essay used for this scholarship may not be used for any other scholarship application.
 - The most outstanding educational experience while attending a college/university
 - Obstacles that have been overcome
 - Aspirations and goals
