CLASSIFIED SENATE SCHOLARSHIP- SUPPLEMENT
ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT AND LEADERSHIP AWARD

This scholarship fund was established by the Board of Directors of the Mesa College Foundation to support classified staff in successfully achieving their educational goals. The scholarship fund is supported by donations from Mesa College staff and the Classified Senate.

TO BE ELIGIBLE, APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- Be a contract classified employee at Mesa College for at least one (1) year
 - Be currently enrolled in at least 3 units at an accredited institution
 - Have completed a minimum of 6 units
 - Have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale for courses completed
- * You are **NOT** eligible if you have received a Classified Senate Scholarship within the **past three years.**

APPLICATION DEADLINE FEBRUARY 27, 2009

Completed applications and all required supporting documents must be received by 4:00 p.m. on February 27, 2009. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

SELECTION PROCESS AND CRITERIA

All completed applications that meet eligibility requirements will be reviewed by a committee composed of representatives from the Mesa College, classified staff, student government, administration, and Mesa College Foundation.

APPLICATIONS WILL BE RATED AS FOLLOWS:

GPA of 3.0 and higher	10 points maximum
Internships/Community Service/Involvement with Senate	50 points maximum
Essay	40 points maximum

RECIPIENT NOTIFICATION AND RELEASE OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Recipients will be notified by mid-April. Awards will be presented on Friday May 8, 2009, at the Annual Scholarship Awards Banquet. Recipients will be honored as special guest and will receive one complimentary dinner ticket. Attendance at the Scholarship Banquet is strongly encouraged so that your achievements can be celebrated and the generosity of the donors publicly acknowledged.

List leadership and/or community service activities in conjunction with the classified Senate in which you have been involved; offices/positions held; and dates of participation. Also please include involvement in committees on campus and office/college/community projects in which you have assisted.

Submit a **typed, well-written essay** on a topic selected from any of the following subjects. Be sure to follow the recommended length of 500 words or less. The essay used for this scholarship may not be used for any other scholarship application.

- The most outstanding educational experience while attending a college/university
- Obstacles that have been overcome
- Aspirations and goals
- What interest or contribution I have done with/for the Classified Senate (Not mandated by a supervisor but voluntary).
