JOHN & KAORI MARSHALL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship fund was established by John F. Marshall, an alumnus of Mesa College, and his wife, Kaori O. Marshall, to recognize and provide financial assistance to deserving Mesa College students who have achieved outstanding scholarship and leadership.

TO BE ELIGIBLE STUDENTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- Be currently enrolled as a full-time student (12 units) at Mesa College
- Be working toward an Associated degree or a transfer program to an accredited four year institution
- Have completed a minimum of 6 units as required for the major
- Have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale
- Have a declared major in either Business Administration with an emphasis in Accounting, or in Liberal Arts with an emphasis on Sociology.
- Demonstrate financial need. Verification of financial need will be processed by the Financial Aid Office at Mesa College.

APPLICATION DEADLINE FEBRUARY 29, 2012

Completed applications and all required supporting documents must be received by 5 p.m. on February 29, 2012. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

SELECTION PROCESS AND CRITERIA

All completed applications that meet eligibility requirements will be reviewed by a committee composed of representatives from the Mesa College faculty, classified staff, student government, administration, and the Mesa College Foundation.

APPLICATIONS WILL BE RATED AS FOLLOWS:

Biographical Questionnaire	10 points maximum
GPA of 3.0 and higher	20 points maximum
Leadership/Community Service	20 points maximum
Essay	30 points maximum
Recommendation letters (2)	10 points maximum
Demonstrated Financial Need	10 points maximum

RECIPIENT NOTIFICATION AND RELEASE OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Recipients will be notified by mid-April. Awards will be presented on April 27, 2012, at the Annual Scholarship Awards Banquet. Recipients will be honored as special guests and will receive one complimentary dinner ticket. Attendance at the Scholarship Banquet is required for release of scholarship funds. Non-attendance will, in most cases, result in forfeiture of scholarship award.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Applicants are requested to submit the following documentation:

1. Submit a fully completed biographical questionnaire. All information requested must be provided.
2. Submit **unofficial** transcripts.
3. Submit two current letters of recommendation on official letterhead:
 - One (1) from a Mesa College faculty member (counselors are faculty members) specific to this scholarship and discussing your academic achievement and/or progress in your planned educational program.
 - One (1) from a person (faculty, non-faculty, or community member) who can provide information regarding your active involvement on campus and/or voluntary community service activities.
4. Submit a well-written original essay about your background, your educational and career goals, and your interest in your major. Your essay should not exceed 500 words.
