TO BE ELIGIBLE STUDENTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- Business or Science student
- Completed at least 12 units at Mesa College
- Demonstrated academic excellence with a GPA of at least 3.0
- Currently enrolled in at least 9 units at Mesa College
- Demonstrated community and/or college activities involvement

APPLICATION DEADLINE FEBRUARY 29, 2012

Completed applications and all required supporting documents must be received by 5:00 p.m. on February 29, 2012. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

SELECTION PROCESS AND CRITERIA

All completed applications that meet eligibility requirements will be reviewed by a committee composed of representatives from the Mesa College faculty, classified staff, student government, and administration.

APPLICATIONS WILL BE RATED AS FOLLOWS:

Biographical Questionnaire	20 points maximum
GPA of 3.0 and higher	25 points maximum
Essay (Business or science topic)	35 points maximum
Recommendation letter (minimum of 2)	20 points maximum

RECIPIENT NOTIFICATION AND RELEASE OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Recipients will be notified by mid-April. Awards will be presented on Friday April 27, 2012, at the annual *Scholarship Awards Banquet*. Recipients will be honored as special guests and will receive one complimentary dinner ticket. Attendance at the Scholarship Banquet is strongly encouraged so that your achievements can be celebrated and the generosity of the donors publicly acknowledged.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Applicants are requested to submit the following documentation:

1. Submit a fully completed biographical questionnaire. All information requested must be provided.
2. Submit **unofficial** transcripts.
3. Submit two current letters of recommendation on official letterhead:
 - One (1) from Mesa College Counselor. Letter should include personal accomplishments and/or progress in your planned educational program
 - One (1) from a person (faculty or non-faculty) who can provide information regarding your personal accomplishments and/or progress in your planned educational program.
4. Submit a well-written original essay about your interest and accomplishments in business or sciences. The essay should be typed, double spaced and no longer than two pages.
