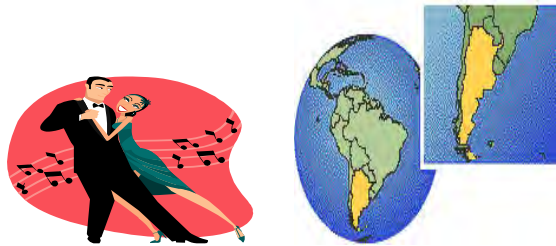


Fall 2012 - Buenos Aires, Argentina



*With San Diego City College and the SD Community College District**

Format: Anthro 392A will meet once prior to departure; Anthro 102 and 103 will begin in San Diego prior to departure. Program will continue for 10 weeks in Argentina.

Dates: August 23 - November 3, 2012.

Housing: Single room in host family with two meals daily, possibly another option

Cost: TBD. Price includes round trip airfare, ground transportation, housing, multiple excursions related to the Cross Cultural Studies in Argentina class, visit to gaucho ranch, medical/travel insurance, on-site support, etc.

Eligibility Requirements:

Completion of 12 units and good academic standing by the end of Spring 2012.

- 12 unit minimum enrollment. Classes will include Spanish 102, 201 and 202 taught by on-site instructors. Students should have taken Spanish 101 or the equivalent prior to departure. The 3-unit Cross-Cultural Studies in Argentina class is required. A one-week break will be scheduled during the program and optional excursions to Iguazu Falls will be offered.
- Classes are CSU and/or UC transferable except Anthro 392 which is only CSU transferable.
- Financial Aid is available for students who qualify. Students who are U.S. citizens and eligible for a Pell Grant are encouraged to apply for a Gilman scholarship worth \$3K-\$5K. Go to www.iie.org/gilman to learn more. Application deadline is March 1, 2012.
- Cost does not include registration fees, books, some or most meals, personal expenses, reciprocity arrival tax, and, if applicable, passport fee, etc.
