

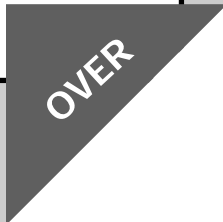


Transfer

There is a lot more to transfer than just this checklist. Pick up a Transfer Guide in the Transfer Center, and stay in touch with a counselor.

Transfer Checklist

- Career Objective** – What is yours? If undecided, utilize the services and resources in the Career Center, located in I3-202.
- Major** – What is your major? Come to the Transfer Center, located in I3-202, to explore majors related to your career objectives.
- University** – What schools offer your major? Utilize college catalogs, brochures, and computers in the Transfer Center to explore potential universities. Choosing one school is never enough when planning your educational pathway.
- Campus Visits** – Visit the campuses of your potential universities. Consider things like location and student environment.
- Educational Plan** – Create an Ed plan with a counselor. Do not waste time taking classes that you do not need. General Counseling is located on the 3rd floor of the I-400 building and EOPS is located in I3-101.
- English and Math Requirements** – Get them out of the way. Do not wait until your last semester to take these courses.
- Passing Grades** – Complete all your courses with passing grades. Receiving a D, F, W, or NC will delay your transfer.



- University Applications** – Apply to the schools you are interested in transferring to by the deadline and send in necessary materials. Remember, application periods are usually 1 year prior to transfer.
- Financial Aid** – Apply, even if you do not think you'll qualify. It can't hurt! When filing your FAFSA, be sure to list the universities you are applying to.
- Housing** – Inquire about housing. Many universities offer housing, some specifically for transfer students.
- Get Accepted** – Then decide which university you will attend. After receiving responses from the schools you applied to, decide which one you will attend.
- Intent to Enroll** – Submit all required paperwork and fees to the school you chose. Make sure you know the deadlines for submitting fees, paperwork, and transcripts. Don't get left behind!
