

Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) Requirements 2019 - 2020

The Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) is a general education pattern that will fulfill all lower-division general education requirements at all California State University (CSU) campuses and most University of California (UC) campuses / majors. It is also accepted by some private / independent / out-of-state universities.

For assistance in determining the most appropriate general education pattern, consult a counselor.

AREA 1 – ENGLISH COMMUNICATION (Minimum 3 semester units; 4-5 quarter units for each group.) **CSU – one course from each group A, B, and C. UC – one course from group A and one course from group B**

CSU United States History, Constitution and American Ideals (CSU Requirement Only)

The California State University, before awarding a degree, requires students to complete courses or examinations that address:

1. The historical development of American institutions and ideals (**Area US-1**),
2. The Constitution of the United States and the operation of representative democratic government under that Constitution (**Area US-2**),
3. The process of California state and local government (**Area US-3**)

This requirement may be fulfilled prior to transfer by completing a combination of the courses listed below that satisfies all three areas of the requirement. Students who have completed equivalent courses outside the State of California must complete a course from Area US-3.
