Information

At the 11/14/2025 CIC meeting some challenges with credit by exam were discussed. There is no mechanism to only allow high school or noncredit students who have taken particular courses to be eligible for credit by exam (but this is sometimes desired). The removal of CPL from three courses (HOSP 101, MULT 121, MULT 123) was discussed and will be reviewed further. J. Estep reported that COMM C1000 was approved without the 6,000 words in assignments.

- * The Meta Steering Committee meets on Friday, November 21, 2025 and J. Estep will be attending.
- * J. Estep reported the Academic Senate will be voting on three resolutions at the next meeting (December 1, 2025). The CRC committee discussed the following resolutions:
 - 2025.11.2: Education Plan Codes Needed
 - 2025.11.3: Proposed SDMC Academic Senate Constitutional Changes
 - 2025.11.1: Vote of No Confidence – SDMC VPA
- * The Mesa Catalog Committee will meet on Tues 12/9/2025 via Zoom. Anyone wishing to join please email J. Estep for the ZOOM link. The next catalog proofing will be available sometime in December/January.
- * The Chancellor's office is preparing a response to the WestEd's report on Mesa's Physical Therapist Assistant Baccalaureate Degree. Changes to the law are being discussed to address some of the challenges (duplication, etc.). Baccalaureate Degree Applications are slowing down.
- * J. Kalchik reported Policies and Procedures (PnP) the Title 5 changes related to Credit for Prior Learning have been released and are now in a 45-day public comment period. CIC, PnP, and the District Student Services Council will submit a joint letter with recommendations. After the comment period, the proposal will go to the Board of Governors, and if approved, the updates will affect our CPL practices.
- * M. Cox on the Program Review process. Program Review writers should submit drafts for their Dean's review by December 1, 2025. All Program Reviews are to be completed by noon February 3, 2026.
- * There were no significant updates for the Committee of Chairs.
- * There was no update on Ethnic Studies.
- * Previously announced meetings to discuss the District GE at City and Miramar have been postponed.
- * There was no update on Cal-GETC.
- * Several Liberal Arts & Science (LBAS) degrees are being adjusted to lower the number of LBAS degrees. The project to convert to fewer, broader LBAS degrees is nearly complete.

- * There was no update on STEM Calculus/AB 1705 but discussion is taking place to create X courses for MATH 121.
- * J. Estep reported the certification of courses for Phase IIA is due in June 2026. It is anticipated that the changes in Meta to ADT degrees will follow the same procedure as Phase I.
- * J. Estep reported Mesa is anticipating to hear back in January regarding the ACCJC accreditation visit.
- * J. Estep reminded the committee of his status as CRC Co-Chair and requested that anyone who might want to be his successor beginning Fall 2026 should contact him and/or I. O'Connor as voting will take place in March 2026.
- * The inclusion of IDEAA in CORs will be a spring priority with M. Cox and J. Estep taking the lead. The CRC will receive IDEAA training in February.
- * Two new ADT templates (MATH 2.0 and PHYS 2.0) for Fall 2026 implementation are being created and should be ready for committee review at the 12/4/2025 CRC meeting.
- * J. Estep reported the Film, Journalism, and Media Production (FJMP) designator was approved for Mesa. With the large number of courses that might use this designator the courses should be reviewed for possibly overlapping other designators.
