- * MSC M. Cox/J. Snyder to approve the November 21, 2024 agenda with the addition of item 4.4 **MATH 118, MATH 141 & MATH 150** – Revisions – Aligned
- * MSC M. Cox/N. Resch to approve the November 7, 2024 minutes. (6 abstentions)

Information

- * CIC specified Work-Based Learning (WBL) is being reviewed every semester. Mesa's Associate Dean Berry sends out an Excel file each semester for Mesa faculty to add WBL information. C. Storey reported that Mesa is doing well in terms of WBL (including courses outside of Career Technical Education). Credit for Prior Learning (CPL) training will happen on January 31, 2025 in San Diego. District Policies and Procedures is looking into an Artificial Intelligence AP.
- * The Program Viability handouts were reviewed and some questions were raised about the final steps of the process. J. Estep will look into adjusting/clarifying the final steps.
- * M. Cox/J. Bernal moved to review the Program Viability documents again at the December 5, 2024 CRC meeting.
- * There was no update on META.
- * The Fall 2024 Plenary included resolutions on AI and slowing down curricular legislation initiatives (including requesting GE/UCTCA/Articulation earlier in the process). A resolution was passed supporting the addition of Nutrition to Life Sciences 5B. Note: Mesa faculty were involved in the writing of this resolution. A resolution to replace objectives with outcomes was voted down. The automatic approval of ethnic studies courses was voted down for fear other disciplines might try to get their courses approved for ethnic studies.
- * Mesa's Academic Senate is reviewing a Taser Resolution. The sense was for CRC to abstain on the Taser Resolution as it is not a curricular issue.
- * Mesa's Catalog Committee continues to review courses and programs in the 2025-26 catalog. The next [catalog Zoom meeting](#) will be 3:00pm on December 10, 2024. Anyone interested in being a member should email J. Estep.
- * It is anticipated there will more information in February 2025 on Mesa's Physical Therapist Assistant Baccalaureate Degree.
- * There was no Ethnic Studies update.
- * The District GE Task Force next meeting will be November 22, 2024. Please contact J. Estep if interested in being on the GE Task Force.
- * There was no update on Cal-GETC.
- * The current LAS Degrees continue to be reviewed in an effort to have broader and fewer degrees to assist students in completing them. The team is meeting in December for further review.
- * MATH 118, MATH 141 & MATH 150 courses are being revised to comply with AB 1705.
- * The AB 1111 handout from District provided the Implementation Plan and Timeline the District will be utilizing to comply with the Common Course Numbering (CCN).
- * Of the five handouts listed under Title 5 changes two of the handouts contained course outline Title 5 changes and three of the handouts pertained to baccalaureate degree programs (bdp) - one contained the Title 5 change and the other two provided information on bdp applications and workforce needs.
- * District has done a report on the TOP to CIP code change and is doing most of the coding for the colleges. The handout from the Chancellor's Office explains the transition.

- * J. Estep presented a comparison chart regarding Course Learning Outcomes (CLOs) being originated in Nuventive and being originated in Meta. The chart will be discussed at the December 5, 2024 CRC meeting. It was suggested that the Meta review process for changing Outcomes might be similar to the CPL process.
- * Implementing IDEAA (Inclusion, Diversity, Equity and Antiracism and Accessibility) into course outlines is underway. The [2024 Curriculum Institute website](#) has IDEAA slide presentations available under + Presentation Materials. It was suggested that possibly the incorporation of IDEAA information should be done at the school level rather than at the department level. J. Estep will be checking out what other colleges are doing and what training if any is needed for the CRCs.
- * The new designator: Community Service Continuing Education (CSCE) was corrected at CIC and is Community Service Community Education.
- * MSC M. Cox/ J. Snyder to approve the change from Community Service Continuing Education (CSCE) is Community Service Community Education.
- * J. Estep thanked members for their participation and approval of the November 12, 2024 virtual vote for COMM C1000 to have partial DE – not fully online DE. CIC approved the partial DE change on November 14, 2024.
