- * A. Hoffman has presented a resolution to the Mesa Academic Senate to amend the Senate's constitution to have CRC chair elections in even numbered years.
- * In the absence of T. Recalde, A. Hoffman informed the committee of the T. Recalde's concern regarding City's new AMSL program award. It is felt there are not enough students to support AMSL awards at both Mesa and City. A. Hoffman will present this concern when the awards are discussed at CIC.
- * Mesa's Academic Senate approved the Board Policies (BPs) & Administrative Procedures (APs) and the AP 4025.2 (Philosophy and Criteria for Baccalaureate Degrees) is anticipated to be approved at the Senate's next meeting.
- * In the absence of H. Eskew, the Ad Hoc Committee update will be placed on the May 5, 2022 CRC agenda. CRC members may contact H. Eskew if they are interested in participating. J. Estep volunteered to be on the committee.
- * J. Parker stated the minimum qualifications for Asian American Studies and Native American/American Indian Studies passed the State Academic Senate and will now go to the Board of Governors for final approval. This information will appear in the April-May edition of NewsBrief.
- * I. O'Connor reported the CIOs and the Chancellor's office do not support AB 1705 which places students directly into transfer math and English courses. Two amendments will be added to AB 1705 to exempt CTE programs and to provide more time for STEM to make adjustments. The Chancellor's office is working on the implementation of AB 1111 common course numbering and AB 928 placement of students into ADTs.
- * The CRC calendar of 2022-2023 meetings was discussed and will be voted on at the May 5, 2022 CRC meeting. The CIC deadlines may be added to the calendar when they become available.
- * CRC members were requested to notify A. Svedberg whether or not they will be returning to the committee for the 2022-2023 academic year.
- * The May 5, 2022 CRC meeting will be in MS 202 as a HyFlex meeting.
