Presently, 83 CCCs have courses that have been granted C-ID numbers.

1311 (+92 from April) courses have been granted C-ID numbers for **15 disciplines**

294 (140 AG) C-ID descriptors have been approved

59 draft descriptors are closed from vetting and FDRGs are currently being convened for consideration of vetting comments.

18 TMCs

347 AA-T and AS-T aligned degrees approved in the Chancellor's Office
