*Spanish classes are 5 weeks long. First week of instruction in Mesa College (June 23-27), next four weeks in Spain (June 30 – July 25).

Eligibility Requirements: 12 units completed (including Spanish 101 or equivalent) and a 2.5 GPA by the end of fall 2013

Cost \$2,450

Included: Study at Colegio Mayor Santa Mónica; housing at a university residence; room and board, 3 meals a day except dinner on Sundays; pre-departure orientation and services; weekend excursions to magnificent Toledo and Segovia; guided tours and cultural visits around Madrid; airport pickup for students who arrive at the designated time on the arrival date; on-site orientation and staff services; use of sports facilities.

Not included: \$100.00 application fee with MLSA. Mesa College tuition (\$46/ per unit); books; roundtrip airfare; airport taxes; return transportation to the airport; personal effects insurance and expenses; optional excursions to El Escorial, Ruta del Quijote, running of the bulls in Pamplona, Barcelona, Cordoba, Sevilla, Granada

All information is subject to change and is pending SDCCD Board approval.

Live and study in Madrid, the capital of Spain and center of Spanish art.

Students enroll in one or two classes for the duration of the program.

Classes are UC, CSU transferable. Instruction in Madrid will be from 9:00am – 12:45pm five days per week.

U.S. departure for all students on June 28th, arrival in Madrid on June 29th, classes start on June 30th.
