



Resolution 97.11.2 – Campus-wide Test Proctoring:

Whereas: the Disabled Student Programs and Services department has offered test proctoring services to support accommodations for students with disabilities in accordance with section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973. Legislation limits the use of DSPS funds for services to student with disabilities only.

Whereas; Adjunct Faculty have reduced or limited office space and time on campus to provide test supervision for students without disabilities that may request a test be given at other than the usual and customary time.

Whereas; some prerequisite challenges require the use of a test proctoring service not related to student accommodation.

Whereas; previous attempts to meet student need for test proctoring created a workload that could not be maintained in the ILC due to limited staffing.

Whereas; data is presently unavailable to support the need for test proctoring services for students without disabilities.

Be it resolved that the Academic Senate establish an Ad Hoc Committee to survey the faculty and student need for campus wide test proctoring and propose steps to request the needed support that may be identified schools according to the formula approved by the President's Cabinet.
