Whereas; Technology Mediated Instruction (TMI) is a fast growing area of instruction and

Whereas; TMI will change student/teacher relationships and

Whereas; The student/teacher relationship is fundamental to the education process and

Whereas; Changes in the student/teacher relationship will influence and change curricula and curricular policy and

Whereas; The Board of Trustees must rely primarily on the Academic Senate for advice and recommendations about curriculum

Therefore be it resolved that: The Mesa College Academic Senate form an Ad Hoc Committee to advise the Academic Senate Executive Committee about formulating and focusing TMI policy recommendations and

Be it further resolved that: This committee be known as the TMI Ad Hoc Committee; that it consist of a chair and four additional faculty members; and that it serve for the remainder of the 1998/1999 school year and for all of the 1999/2000 school year.
