COVID-19 Financial Assistance

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

In order to be eligible for the United Way of San Diego Financial Assistance Grant, students must be:

- Currently enrolled in Fall 2020 classes
- Not eligible for Unemployment Insurance (did not file an IRS 1040s form)

Are one of the following:

- Non-US Citizen
- Undocumented Student
- Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA)
- Non-high school graduate
- Have experienced employment related hardship due to COVID-19
