<p>CAMPUS PROJECT MANAGER - Mesa College has a new Campus Project Manager, Diane Malone. She has hit the campus running and is doing a fine job learning about our projects. She will be a regular attendee at the campus' President Cabinet meetings. In addition, she will be sending out monthly updates on our Proposition S and N projects. Welcome Diane!</p>			
<p>EAST CAMPUS IMPROVEMENT PROJECT - PARKING GARAGE and POLICE SUBSTATION are substantially complete.</p>			
<p>ROSA PARKS MEMORIAL BUS STOP construction commenced and will be completed by February 4, 2010. The official opening ceremony is scheduled for February 25, 2010. At that time, MTS will have two bus stops on the east side of campus - one in front of Allied Health and the other at Rosa Parks Memorial.</p>			
<p>TELECOMMUNICATIONS INFRASTRUCTURE installation work was done in the fire lane on the north side of K-200/L-200 and on the west of L-100/200/500 and will be completed by the end of January 2010.</p>			
<p>STUDENT SERVICES (I-400) BUILDING - Staff and services from the I-400 have been relocated to the Modular Village in Lot #1 in preparation for the demolition of I-400 scheduled for March 2010. ATM has been relocated to the first floor of the LRC, a temporary chiller has been installed to provide power/heat to I-300 and the elevators in I-400 are not operational.</p>			
<p>MODULAR VILLAGE - STUDENT SERVICES PROJECT - The project is substantially complete. Pending items: Shade structures, tables, benches.</p>			
<p>PARKING LOT #1 ROAD - Due to pedestrian safety concerns, the road that splits the parking lot has been re-routed to move vehicular traffic away from the Modular Village.</p>			
<p>PARKING LOTS 2 and 3 - Open for student parking. Combined with lots 1, 4 and the parking structure we now have over 3,400 student parking spaces.</p>			
<p>STADIUM MONDO TRACK AND FIELD PROJECT - Project substantially complete. Pending item: Mondo to complete track lane striping, weather permitting.</p>			
<p>MESA COLLEGE DESIGN CENTER - Classes at Muir (Future Design Center) have been moved back to main campus in preparation for construction/renovation of Muir.</p>			
<p>TUTORING CENTER - Tutoring Center has been relocated to I-207.</p>			
<p>DESIGN PROGRAMMING PHASE - Three projects scheduled to start September 2010: (1) SOCIAL AND BEHAVIORAL SCIENCES, (2) FITNESS CENTER and (3) CAFETERIA, BOOKSTORE and STUDENT UNION BUILDINGS</p>
