### **III. Data Coaches Goals and Outcomes Discussion:**

Bridget explained that the process began with an initial handbook that was drafted about what other colleges do with Data Coaching. This position would be to only serve as a resource to help point our community in the right directions of where data resources are to help guide data conversations in committees, school meetings etc. There is a ton of data in the IE Office, District Office and State and Regional colleges in different formats and there is a need for colleagues who are knowledgeable and that can help point others in that direction. Another goal would be to have a team of equity minded action researchers throughout the campus that extends beyond the IE Office. A bit of research has been done on how Data Coaching is used as part of Student Success Teams and we are thinking about how Data Coaches might be a part of that model. Bridget proposes that MPC approves the proposed next steps that there will be a small workgroup that will be led by: Anda from the IE Office as the lead Data Coaching program and Faculty Partner collaborator, have a small workgroup that can develop the content for the Data Coaching training course so that there are several versions that will be worked out by this workgroup, but have an initial training course for Data Coaches. Going back to the handbook and identifying the expectations of Data Coaches will do: what are the deliverables, what are the roles that they play, what are some suggested activities that they might engage in with the group they represent or that they are working with? Isabel stepped in and mentioned that instead of workgroup it should be called a project, to look if we are comfortable, is this something we should pursue, are there other ideas where this can be applied, how do we move into all the details, and an MPC member to co-lead with Anda. Howard suggested Gina to work with Anda as the co-lead. It was voted that Gina will be the co-lead for this project. IE Office will connect with the Project Team and schedule the next steps.

#### **IV. Pathways Project Grants Funding Update:**

Howard will be sending an email reminder to invite colleagues to apply for funding for their projects. This Friday is the deadline to submit request for funding and posted on the web page you will find projects that were funded and projects that were not funded due to the Chancellor's Office funding restrictions. On November 15<sup>th</sup> the winners will be announced.

#### **V. SOAA Report Update:**

Howard shared that the Self Assessment will be done by next week so it can be shared with the governance groups and after that it will be brought to MPC for approval.

#### **VI. Student Success Teams Roadshow Update:**

Ian shared a PowerPoint on the Roadshows and so far, there has been four and will hold another Roadshow on Friday since more faculty attended on that day. #### **VII. Technology Project Team Update:**

Ian shared a PowerPoint on how their first meeting went and three major projects were identified: website redesign as it relates to Mesa Pathways, inventory existing pathways tools and develop a master list of technology tools already in use, and develop a checklist/buying guide for the adoption of Pathways-related technology and how technology could relate to Pathways. In the next meeting the group will start thinking about timelines. This workgroup meets every 1<sup>st</sup>. and 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesdays via Zoom and still working on a time frame. Next meeting will be on October 20<sup>th</sup> from 2:00-3:00 pm and November 3<sup>rd</sup> from 11am-12pm. If you have any questions, please email Ian. Jennifer shared that the website is underway and the processes on how maps will be displayed will be a gradual process so it can be flexible for anyone needing to update or make changes to their maps.
