Submit your complete application, including all required documents in a single PDF file via email to SDMesalS@sdccd.edu. Complete applications are reviewed first by the committee in the order received. Allow up to 5 weeks after the published deadline for application review before contacting International Student Admissions. Spring 2022 Applications are being accepted until the deadline- November 1, 2021.

BEFORE E-MAILING YOUR APPLICATION, CONFIRM YOUR SUBMISSION IS COMPLETE BY REVIEWING THE FOLLOWING CHECKLIST:

- International Student Application Form (2 pages w/Passport Photo attached)
- Financial Statement (Completed within the past 30 days)
- Health Examination Report (Official form with 6 month recency)
- Application Fee Payment Form
- Transfer Clearance Form (Completed by current International Student Advisor/DSO)

IN ADDITION TO THE APPLICATION PACKET ABOVE, INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING SUPPLEMENTAL DOCUMENTATION:

- Copy of biographical passport page
- Copy of F-1 visa or Copy of F-1 visa change of status approval letter (if applicable)
- Copy of most recent I-94 (if applicable)
- ETS login information for official TOEFL Score results
- Copy of official High School Transcripts showing proof of graduation (translated)
- Copy of official U.S. College or University Transcripts (if applicable)
- Comprehensive Evaluation of Foreign College or University Transcripts (if applicable)

-  I understand that only admitted students will be issued a Form I-20 and acknowledge that incomplete applications are subject to denial.
