Wrong! You can have any number of guarantees signed, and then choose which one you want to use. You may apply to San Diego State University TAG, University of California, San Diego U-Link, and University of California, Los Angeles TAP if you qualify, and one TAG with the other 6 Universities of California (UC) that offer TAG program.

Did you know?

- That one of the outstanding transfer guarantee programs available to you is the University Link Program. If you are in your first year of college, you can sign the contract and attend UCSD with a 3.5 GPA, Veterans and foster youth can sign at anytime
- Don't forget to check the Transfer Center events page to stay up to date on all of the great opportunities available. Remember we're here to help you succeed!
