For those of you who have been accepted for transfer Fall 2013, don't forget to follow through on all your admissions requirements. You have deadlines to meet for submitting transcripts, and other documentation and fees.

For those of you transferring for Fall 2014, now is the time to prepare for your applications to CSU and UC schools. Applications are due by November 30, 2013. There are some wonderful planning tools for you to use. In CSU Mentor you can use the Transfer Planner to organize and keep track of your General Education transfer requirements. For UC schools, use the Transfer Admission Planner. This connects you to the UC TAG and UC Application pages.
