Application Assistance

Make your transfer plan a successful one. Apply to at least FIVE schools. If you qualify, there are fee waivers for up to four CSU and four UC Applications. A fee waiver is also available for all private schools in California, and many out of state ones. The basic criteria is Pell-Grant eligibility.

Remember to stop by the Transfer Center to get any application help that you might need.



Transfer Myth: I won't be able to get the job I want, or go on to grad school if I don't get accepted to my top transfer schools?

Wrong! Many studies show that attending a fourth or fifth choice school can be more advantageous than attending your top schools. Finishing in the top third of a less selective school is better than finishing in the bottom third of a more selective school. What matters is what you do while you're there, and how well you plan for the future.

CSU San Marcos: You can establish CSU San Marcos local area status by taking any transferrable class through one of the North County Community Colleges (during spring 2015) and designating it on your application by November
