Appeal? What is that?

If you are denied admission to the school of your choice, you should appeal to give yourself another opportunity of being admitted. Attend one of the ***Transfer Center's Appeal Workshops in March***

Transfer Myth: "I can't afford to attend a private university"

Wrong! There are many private universities where the tuition is close to public schools. You have to do some research! Private universities also offer many more scholarships and grants than public ones, and can reduce the overall cost. It is common for many private schools to offer **discounted tuition, so make sure to ask.**
