**Transfer Myth:** I can only sign one TAG (Transfer Admission Guarantee) contract!

Truth: SDSU still has many majors that offer TAG contracts. There are still six University of California schools that continue to offer TAG contracts. UCSD offers the University Link Program for first year students, veterans and foster youth. Check with the transfer center and Counseling for more information.

## Did you know?

You need to complete all of the steps below to receive priority admissions from an ADT (Associate Degree for Transfer):

1. meet with a counselor to create an education plan in your major
2. apply for graduation through Reg-E at least two semesters ahead
3. indicate your ADT major on your CSU Mentor application

The University Link and UC TAG contracts are completed separately from the UC application (which is available to be filled out starting August 1, and can be sent starting November 1). The SDSU TAG is applied for through the regular CSU Mentor application.

## Things to Look For

Attend a Transfer Center Workshop. This will help clarify what you need to know. Stop by the Transfer Center in I4-306 or phone 388 2473 to enroll.

Make a counseling appointment. The rules covering transfer requirements are complicated.
